RE: SPECIAL PARKING ARRANGEMENTS DURING HARVEST FESTIVAL
TUESDAY, SEPTEMBER 8 THROUGH SUNDAY, SEPTEMBER 12

The Harvest Festival brings with it street and parking lot closures that call for special arrangements to ensure that customers can find parking near businesses and employees have reserved parking.

Starting Tuesday, September 7, the Tiller Lot will be occupied with carnival rides. Those who normally park in this lot should park in the Rifle lot that is down the hill on the southeast corner of Vance and Grandview. This lot is owned by the movie theaters, who will allow parking for employees and customers during the above time period. Do not park there any other time.

Starting Friday, September 10 at noon, Grandview will be closed from Webster east to Teller. The upper lot on Grandview next to the tracks will be reserved for customers only. Starting Friday morning, merchants and employees who normally park there should park in the lot southeast of Vance and Grandview.

We will have volunteers monitoring this lot to ensure your customers have access to close parking. This is being done to minimize any loss of business you would encounter if your regular customers cannot find nearby parking. Please leave this lot open for customers only.

Anyone who needs special consideration because they need close parking should contact Jason Dennison at 303-420-6100. We're doing our best to work this out for all and it will require that some of us sacrifice a bit for the cause.

Our HOTA board and staff have talked extensively with the organizers of the Harvest Festival to ensure this year's festival is friendlier to businesses. Parking is a critical component. In addition to these special parking instructions, we will have two golf carts available to bring employees and customers to and from their cars if needed.

Business owners: please share this with your employees and pledge cooperation from all. Let's make this year's festival a success not only for the additional foot traffic it brings, but also for our regular customers who we don't want to inconvenience during the festival.
